RE: Sign-up/registration for the 2022-2023 school year

Planning is now underway for the newest season of the MasterMinds and the Interscholastic Chess League (ICL) programs; **a season which promises expanded growth in participation as schools continue to recover from COVID concerns.** MasterMinds is a team-based, academic quiz bowl-style competition similar to the old College Bowl program. It provides a competitive structure to recognize the strengths of academically talented students. The Interscholastic Chess League allows students to test their analytical skills in the classic game of logic and strategy against the talents of the brightest students from other schools.

We are pleased to announce that schools will have the option to sign up for MasterMinds and/or Chess in a couple of ways: as a service of the Erie1 BOCES (by cross-contract if you are not a component district) or through the non-profit CYPRAS. With the start of classes not far away, we hope that your school will make plans to join us for another fun and engaging year of interscholastic competitions. Both MasterMinds and Chess have been important parts of the extracurricular offerings at dozens of schools around the Greater Buffalo area for years; all part of the more than 100 schools across upstate NY that participated last year.

**If you are unsure of interest among your students, you can schedule a demonstration where we come to your school -- either during lunch or after school -- and show your students what the programs are like. If you are interested, please check the appropriate box on the enclosed form and return it as soon as possible or call 585-473-0864 to schedule a demonstration.**

After several years of frozen program fees, and facing inflationary pressures, there are increases in this year's rates. However, we are pleased to announce that those increases are being kept under the two-percent limits that the state sets for budgetary increases. The fee for MasterMinds for the 2022-2023 season will be at **\$779/team** and the cost for the optional JV program is **\$346** (with varsity participation as a prerequisite). The cost for a team in the Interscholastic Chess League stands at **\$349**.

In-person play remains the gold standard for both chess and quiz bowl. But recognizing that COVID and its variants could be a concern, we want to assure you that we have plans to make our programs as vibrant and safe as we can. If circumstances make in-person play for either program an unacceptable risk, we will suspend play until conditions improve. If conditions warrant, we can even convert to remote play until such time as health officials deem it reasonable to resume in-person play. Having completed a full season of remote play, we know how to do it, and do it effectively. Mask-wearing is always permitted but is not mandatory.

To register and participate in MasterMinds and/or Chess for the 2022-2023 season, the enclosed registration form should be completed and returned, with a requested deadline of **Friday, September 23, 2022**. If you are considering working with another school to field a joint/shared team -- something that is permitted -- let us know. Previous non-participants in MasterMinds will still receive a new school orientation.

With a return to normal programming, this is a sensible time to become involved!
